Every apparent ending flags off a new beginning; and so has been the case with BAKhabar! Let us redeploy the pledge of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan - "... from the seed which we sow today, there may spring up a mighty tree, whose branches, like those of the banyan of the soil, shall in their turn strike firm roots into the earth ... whose sons shall go forth throughout the length and breadth of the land to preach the gospel of free inquiry, of large-hearted toleration, and of pure morality."

From the Doctor's Desk

## "Eye Health As You Grow Old"

Eyesight is one of the greatest gifts given to us by the Almighty. Many eye-related problems or diseases that occur with advancing age are not characterized by noticeable symptoms or pain. Therefore, early diagnosis and adequate treatment are the keys to prevent serious damage and blindness. This article explores few common eyesight problems and their related diagnosis and treatment.

## COMMON PROBLEMS:

The conditions which need regular screening are:
PRESBYOPIA: Age related loss of ability to see close objects or small prints; usually corrected with appropriate reading glasses.

FLOATERS: Tiny spots or specks that float across the field of vision; can be normal but may sometimes signal a more serious problem.

CATARACT: Clouding of the lens of the eye, which could lead to blurry vision or loss of eye sight; can be safely corrected with surgery.

GLAUCOMA: A group of diseases in which the pressure inside the eye becomes too high for the normal functioning of the retina and the optic nerve.

MACULAR DEGENERATION: Deterioration of the macula (central part of the retina that distinguishes fine details), which causes gradual loss of vision.

DIABETIC RETINOPATHY: Vision problems originating from diabetes; occur when small blood vessels stop delivering blood to the retina properly, which results in distorted eye sight.

## RECOMMENDED VISUAL SCREENING:

1. Regularly visit a doctor's clinic to diagnose any eye problems; if not, visit an eye specialist to prevent the above problems.
2. For people between the ages of 20-39, examination of the eyes at least once in this period is highly recommended.
3. For people between the age of 40-60, yearly examination of the eyes is recommended.
For people 65 years and older, examination by a qualified ophthalmologist at least twice a year is highly recommended.
4. If you have a family history of diabetes, you must visit an ophthalmologist to get your retina examined at least once every year.
5. If you have a family history of Glaucoma, it is recommended that you get your eyes examined by a Specialist and seek advice.
